TECHNOLOGY AT THE SERVICE OF COMEDY

One of the highlights of this show is the use of technology in the service of improvisation and comedy. Through a homemade device that allows the wireless transmission of any song or sound, Agro surprises and makes each improvisation more complete, selecting with dizzying speed the appropriate track for each moment that arises throughout the show.

The special feature of this show is the interaction with the passing cars, which unknowingly become an integral part of the show and the gags.





Throughout his career, Agro has improvised at festivals on 4 continents, performing in more than 25 countries.

AGRO THE CLOWN

Luca Della Gatta began studying circus at the "Carampa" school in Madrid for a year. During this time he approached the life of the clown and began to study physical theatre, clowning and mime at the "Nouveau Colombier" school in the same city, directed by José Piris, a direct student of Marcel Marceau. He also had the opportunity to study with Roberto Escobar and Igon Lerchundi at their mime school in Buenos Aires and continued with mime at the "Accademia arti mimiche" in Turin.

In 2014 he graduated from Philip Radice's "University of Performing Arts' in Turin, Italy. He has worked with his clown Agro since 2010 in street shows in the main European cities and in international street festivals. He worked as a clown for two years in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico in the show Rhythms of the Night where he met and worked with René Bazinet.

From 2019 he is part of the Collectif Primavez.

In 2019 he won the 1st Prize (Pave D'or) at the Festival Artistes de Rue de Vevey (Switzerland) with the show ImproLocura.

<u>Car Wash</u> is 40 minutes of untamed froth.

All audiences ready to be splashed by the comedy.

A show designed for the street, perfect for your roundabout, street, avenue...

Maximum I show per day.

Scenic space

Ideal: A square, promenade, street, avenue or roundabout. The flow of cars should be moderate and occasional so as not to create too many obstacles to traffic.

* Obviously, the safety of the audience is essential, so they should not encroach on the road and should be able to stay in a safe area from which to watch the show and allow the artist to interact with them.

Set-up time

The set-up of the space and the artist's make-up are part of the show, however it will be necessary for the artist to check the sound system prior to the start of the show.

Sound

Es conveniente que los organizadoIt is desirable that the organisers provide an additional sound system and connection to electricity through a normal 220V socket to power the microphone receiver with large jack input (6.35mm).

Scenography
